Enclosed please find a copy of the executed Tenth Modification of Effective Date of Unilateral Administrative Order for Remedial Design, Remedial Action, and Operation and Maintenance, U.S. EPA Docket No. CERCLA-01-2012-0045 ("Order"). This is the tenth modification to the effective date of the Order. This tenth modification changes the Order's effective date from September 3, 2013 to November 1, 2013.

On October 10, 2012, a proposed Supplemental Consent Decree with Defendant AVX Corporation was lodged with the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts that would resolve the dispute between the United States and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and AVX, including AVX's liabilities under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, at the Site. The public submitted comments on the proposed settlement through December 17, 2012. On June 11, 2013, following consideration of the public comments, the United States and the Commonwealth filed a motion to enter the proposed Supplemental Consent Decree. Since then, Buzzards Bay Coalition has filed a motion for leave to intervene as well as a memorandum of law in opposition to the motion to enter the proposed Supplemental Consent Decree. EPA is now extending the effective date of the Order to provide time for the Court to review the proposed settlement.
