Pursuant to our discussion today the chemical-specific ARARs that would be appropriate for this site are the soil and water cleanup target levels specified in Chapter 62-777, Florida Administrative Code. The current version of that rule is available at http://www.dep.state.fl.us/waste/quick_topics/rules/documents/62-777/62-777.pdf.
