I. JURISDICTION

This Administrative Order on Consent ("Consent Order") is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the President of the United States by Section 122(g)(4) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 ("CERCLA"), Pub. L. No. 99-499, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(4), to reach settlements in actions under Sections 106(a) and 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(a) and 9607(a). The authority vested in the President has been delegated to the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") by Executive Order 12580, 52 Fed. Reg. 2923 (January 29, 1987) and delegated to the Regional Administrators of the EPA by EPA Delegation No. 14-14-E (issued September 13, 1987, amended by memorandum June 17, 1988), and further re-delegated to the Director, Waste Management Division, EPA, Region IV.

This Consent Order is entered into voluntarily by and between EPA and those settling de minimis PRPs ("Respondents")

who have signed this Consent Order and are listed in Attachment A to this Consent Order. Respondents agree to undertake all actions required by the terms and conditions of this Consent Order. Respondents further consent to and will not contest EPA's jurisdiction to issue this Consent Order or to implement or enforce its terms.

## II. PURPOSE

By entering into this Consent Order, the mutual objectives of EPA and the Respondents are to reach a settlement between the parties which allows each Respondent to make a cash payment, including a premium as specified herein, to settle its respective alleged liability for response costs incurred or to be incurred at or in connection with the Site. EPA and the Respondents enter into this Consent Order to avoid the potential for difficult, prolonged and complicated litigation between EPA and the Respondents, and other potentially responsible parties.

## III. DEFINITIONS

A. "De Minimis Cost Matrix" shall mean the summary prepared by EPA which identifies the volumetric share, expressed in total gallons of waste oil sent to the Site, and the cost share (EPA Past Costs, PRP Past Costs, Future Costs) and premium payment assigned to each de minimis PRP, attached as Attachment B.

B. "Future Response Costs" shall mean any further response costs, including, but not limited to, direct and indirect costs that may be incurred by the United States at the Site after

the effective date of this Consent Order, and for which the Respondents are potentially liable.

C. "Matters Addressed" shall mean all response actions which have been taken at the Site, or may in the future be undertaken at the Site, including, but not limited to, removal actions, remedial actions, the Area-Wide Ground Water RI/FS, the Wetlands Impact Study and the remedial actions required by EPA's three Records of Decision, as authorized under CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601, et seq., and all costs incurred or to be incurred at the Site. Further, for those Respondents who also are PRPs at the Bay Drums Site, Matters Addressed shall not mean any past or future response activities conducted at the Bay Drums Site by EPA or any other Bay Drums PRPs, including the Bay Drums PRPs' share of the costs of the Area-Wide Ground Water RI/FS and Wetlands Impact Study.

D. "Past Response Costs" shall mean all Site response costs incurred by any person(s) or entity, including EPA, prior to the effective date of this Consent Order, plus accrued interest on all such costs through such date.

E. "Records of Decision" or "RODs" shall mean the EPA Records of Decision relating to the Site dated as follows: (1) June 21, 1993, (soils, sediments and surface water); (2) August 9, 1993, (Area-Wide ground water for Southern Surficial and Floridan Aquifers underlying the Peak Oil Site and the Bay Drums Site); and (3) June 28, 1994 (Central and South wetlands), and all attachments thereto.

F. "Respondents" shall mean those de minimis potentially responsible parties ("PRPs) listed in Attachment A who have signed this Consent Order.

G. "United States" shall mean the United States of America, its departments, agencies and instrumentalities.

H. "Site" shall mean the Peak Oil Superfund Site, encompassing approximately 4.5 acres, located in Brandon, east of Tampa, Hillsborough County, Florida, as well as all areas to which waste oil and hazardous substances released at the Site have migrated, including but not limited to the South and Central Wetlands and the Floridan and Southern Surficial Aquifers as described herein.

I. "Waste Oil" shall mean all waste oils and other waste fluids and lubricant-type materials containing hazardous substances, as that term is defined by Section 101(14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(14), which were obtained from vehicles, ships, engines, machines, equipment or any other source(s) and transported to the Peak Oil Site for treatment and/or disposal.

#### IV. STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. The Peak Oil Superfund Site, located in Brandon, east of Tampa, Florida, was operated between the early 1950's and the mid-1980's by the Peak Oil Company as a waste oil re-refining facility. During the years of its operation, the Peak Oil Company handled waste oil from many different sources, including, but not limited to, auto and truck crankcases, hydraulic oils, gear box oils, transmission fluids, transformer oils and other

waste oils and fluids. These waste oils and fluids were contaminated with heavy metals such as lead, chromium, cadmium, arsenic and mercury, and a variety of organic and solvent-type chemical compounds, and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs).

2. As a result of the Peak Oil Company's operations, many areas of the Site, including surface waters, soils, sediments and ground water, became contaminated with hazardous substances (as defined by Section 101 (14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(14)) including organic chemical compounds, heavy metals and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). In 1985, EPA initiated an on-site removal action to incinerate the oily, acidic contaminated waste oil sludges contained in an open, unlined pit at the rear of the Site. In 1989-1990, EPA conducted additional removal actions to remove contaminated waste oils, sludges and other waste fluids from abandoned, deteriorating on-site storage tanks, and to excavate and remove contaminated soils.

3. In 1986, the Peak Oil Superfund Site was jointly listed with the adjacent Bay Drums Superfund Site on EPA's National Priorities List ("NPL"). However, because different operations were conducted at the two Sites resulting in different types of contaminants being released at the Sites, EPA decided to consider them as two separate sites.

4. In 1989, EPA and a group of Peak Oil Site potentially responsible parties ("Peak Oil PRPs") signed two Administrative Consent Orders for the performance of the Remedial Investigation

and Feasibility Study ("RI/FS") at the Site. Two RI/FS projects were conducted: one for the surface media at the Peak Oil Site (soils, sediments and surface waters), and one for the ground water underlying the Peak Oil Site and the adjacent Bay Drums Site and Reeves Southeastern Site. Because the aquifers underlying the Peak Oil Site initially were thought to be part of the same aquifer system underlying the Bay Drums and Reeves Southeastern Superfund Sites, EPA required that the ground water at all three Sites be evaluated in a single RI/FS. As a result, the Peak Oil PRPs along with the Reeves Southeastern Corporation, signed an "Area-Wide Ground Water RI/FS Consent Order" and jointly funded and performed the RI/FS for the area-wide ground water underlying all three sites. Subsequently, a group of Bay Drums PRPs signed the Consent Order and paid a portion of the costs.

5. The RI/FS projects were completed in 1992. The results of the RI's indicate that soils, sediments, surface waters and ground water are contaminated with a variety of hazardous substances.

6. The Area-Wide ground water RI/FS identified three areas of concern: the Northern Surficial Aquifer, which is primarily impacted by heavy metals; the Southern Surficial Aquifer, which is impacted by volatile organic compounds and heavy metals; and the Floridan Aquifer (a primary source of drinking water), which is impacted by volatile organic compounds and heavy metals. Further evaluation of the RI/FSs indicated that the contaminants

in the Southern Surficial and Floridan Aquifers emanated from the Peak Oil Site and the Bay Drums Site, while contaminants in the Northern Surficial Aquifer emanated from the Reeves Southeastern Site. Because there are two separate and distinct areas of ground water contamination, with different sources of contamination, EPA decided that remedial action for the Floridan and Southern Surficial Aquifers underlying the Peak Oil Site and the Bay Drums Site would be set forth in one ROD, while remedial action for the Northern Surficial Aquifer underlying the Reeves Southeastern Site would be set forth in a separate ROD.

7. Based on the results of the RI/FS projects, EPA prepared its Proposed Plans for remedial action at the Peak Oil Site and presented them to the public at public meetings. After the close of each public comment period, EPA issued a ROD. The first ROD was issued on June 21, 1993, and addresses the contaminated soils, sediments and surface waters at the Peak Oil Site. The second ROD was issued on August 9, 1993, and addresses the area-wide ground-water contamination in the Southern Surficial and Floridan Aquifers underlying the Peak Oil and Bay Drums Sites. A separate ROD was issued for Northern Surficial Aquifer underlying the Reeves Southeastern Site.

8. EPA conducted a Wetlands Impact Study on two wetland systems (Central and South Wetlands) located near the Site which were believed to have been impacted by contaminants released from the Site. In April 1994, EPA finalized its Feasibility Study for the wetlands. On May 11, 1994, EPA held a public meeting to

present its Proposed Plan for the wetlands. On June 28, 1994, EPA issued its third ROD for the Site which addresses the wetlands.

9. Attached hereto as Attachment B and incorporated by reference herein is the De Minimis Cost Matrix which lists the total volume in gallons that each Respondent contributed to the Site. The volume attributed to each Respondent is based on Peak Oil Company records (canceled checks, check stubs, invoices, and drivers' logs), Respondents' responses to EPA's Information Requests, Respondents' affidavits submitted to the Peak Oil PRP Generators Group, and testimony of former independent haulers and former Peak Oil Company employees. Based on these sources of information, EPA has determined that each Respondent listed in Attachments A and B arranged for the transport for disposal or treatment of hazardous substances owned or possessed by such Respondent, to the Site, or accepted hazardous substances for transport to the Site.

10. Information currently known to EPA indicates that each Respondent listed in Attachment A contributed 22,000 gallons or less of waste oil to the Site.

11. In performing removal actions, the Wetlands Impact Study, oversight of the Peak Oil RI/FS projects and other Site response activities, EPA has incurred outstanding costs as of July 31, 1994, in the sum of approximately \$6,445,553.71. For purposes of calculating de minimis payment amounts under this

Consent Order only, EPA has reduced the "EPA Past Costs" component on the De Minimis Cost Matrix to \$4,610,902.

12. In evaluating the settlement embodied in this Consent Order, EPA has considered the potential costs of remediating the Site taking into account possible cost overruns in completing remedial actions and possible future costs if these remedial actions are not protective of human health and the environment.

**V. DETERMINATIONS**

Based upon the Findings of Fact set forth above and on the administrative record for this Settlement, EPA has determined that:

1. The Peak Oil Site is a "facility" as defined in Section 101(9) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(9).
2. Each Respondent is a "person" as defined in Section 101(21) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(21).
3. Each Respondent is a "potentially responsible party" under Sections 107(a) and 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607(a) and 9622(g)(1).
4. The waste oils transported to and treated and/or disposed at the Site contained "hazardous substances" within the meaning of Section 101(14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(14).
5. There has been an actual or threatened "release" of a hazardous substance from the Site as that term is defined in Section 101(22) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(22).

6. Prompt settlement with the Respondents is practicable and in the public interest in accordance with Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1).

7. In accordance with Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1), payments required to be made by each Respondent pursuant to this Consent Order represent only a minor portion of the total response costs incurred or to be incurred at the Site by the Peak Oil PRPs, which EPA, based upon currently available information, estimates to range between approximately \$18,000,000 and \$24,000,000.

8. The amount of hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent and the toxic or other hazardous effects of the hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent are minimal in comparison to other amounts of hazardous substances at the Site within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1)(A) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1)(A).

#### VI. ORDER

Based upon the administrative record for this Settlement and the Findings of Fact and Determinations set forth above, and in consideration of the promises and covenants set forth herein, it is hereby AGREED TO AND ORDERED:

#### Payment

1. Each Respondent shall pay the amount specified in either Menu Option 1 or Menu Option 2 as set forth in Attachment B to this Consent Order. Each Respondent shall be responsible for selecting its preferred payment option by marking

the appropriate box and inserting the payment amount where indicated on the signature page found at the end of this Consent Order.

AFTER THIS CONSENT ORDER IS FINALIZED BY EPA PURSUANT TO SECTION VI, PARAGRAPHS 22 AND 24, EPA WILL SEND A WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE RESPONDENTS WHICH WILL NOTIFY THEM OF THE ADDRESS WHERE PAYMENT MUST BE SENT AND THE FORM OF PAYMENT. PAYMENT IS DUE WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF EPA'S WRITTEN NOTICE.

2. EPA has established two payment options ("Menu Options") because there are contingencies which could significantly affect the scope and costs of remediation of the Floridan and Surficial Aquifers underlying the Peak Oil Site and the adjacent Bay Drums Site. Menu Option 1 (the "best-case scenario") assumes that because two old Floridan Aquifer "production wells" at the Peak Oil Site and the adjacent Bay Drums Superfund Site have been plugged and abandoned, the levels of contaminants in the Floridan Aquifer will decline below cleanup standards, such that active remediation of the Floridan Aquifer will not be required. Menu Option 1 also assumes that an additional treatment process to remove heavy metals known as chemical precipitation will not be needed in either Aquifer. The estimated remediation costs to be incurred by the Peak Oil PRPs for implementing the best-case scenario is \$10,027,019.

3. Menu Option 2 (the "worst-case scenario") assumes that ground water in both Aquifers will need to be remediated through a "pump and treat" system, and that chemical precipitation will be required to remove heavy metals from both Aquifers. If such a worst-case scenario occurs, the Peak Oil PRPs' estimated

remediation costs at the Peak Oil Site is \$15,326,019. However, it is possible that only portions of the worst-case scenario may materialize, for example, even if the Floridan Aquifer must be remediated, chemical precipitation may not be needed in either Aquifer, or it may be needed in one or both of the Aquifers. Or, the Floridan Aquifer may not need to be remediated but chemical precipitation may be needed in the Surficial Aquifer. Therefore, it is possible that the Peak Oil PRPs' cost of remediation under a worst-case scenario could be less than \$15,326,019.

4. As of the effective date of this Order, the old production wells have been plugged and abandoned. However, EPA will not be able to make a final determination as to whether the Floridan Aquifer will need active remediation or whether chemical precipitation will be necessary in one or both Aquifers until after additional sampling of new monitoring wells has been completed, the remedy addressing soils and sediments has been implemented and remediation of the Southern Surficial Aquifer has begun. EPA's final decision may not be made for a number of years after the effective date of this Consent Order.

5. The total cost of cleaning up the Peak Oil Site will be affected by EPA's final decisions concerning the Floridan and Surficial Aquifers. The Menu Option approach takes this cost uncertainty into account and allows each Respondent to determine the level of risk it wishes to assume in entering into a settlement with EPA.

6. Respondents who select Menu Option 1 will be paying approximately \$4.02 for each gallon of waste oil assigned to it in EPA's De Minimis Cost Matrix. Respondents who select Menu Option 2 will be paying approximately \$5.52 for each gallon of waste oil assigned to it in EPA's De Minimis Cost Matrix. The amount to be paid by each Respondent under either Menu Option is set forth in Attachment B and includes a payment for: (a) past response costs incurred at or in connection with the Site by any person or entity, including EPA; (b) estimated future response costs to be incurred at or in connection with the Site, based on either a "best-case scenario" or a "worst-case scenario" selected by each Respondent; and (c) a 100 percent premium to cover the risk that response costs to be incurred at or in connection with the Site will exceed the estimated costs of cleanup under either Menu Option, and the risk that costs may increase as a result of a later decision by EPA to modify the remedy or select a new remedy because the original remedy selected by EPA is determined not to be protective of human health and the environment. EPA will retain the first \$4,610,902 generated by Peak Oil Site de minimis settlements under this Consent Order and any subsequent Consent Orders and apply those funds to EPA's outstanding past costs (\$4,300,000 will be applied to the Peak Oil Site Source, account number G9; \$210,902 will be applied to the Area-Wide Ground Water RI/FS, account number AG; and \$100,000 will be applied to the Area-Wide Wetlands, account number FG). Additionally, any penalty assessments paid by a Respondent as

part of its settlement amount for failure to comply with an EPA Information Request or Unilateral Order will be retained by EPA. It is EPA's intent to transfer any de minimis settlement proceeds exceeding the \$4,610,902 (except penalty payments) into a separate trust fund to be established by a group of non-de minimis Peak Oil PRPs for future Site cleanup costs, but only if those PRPs enter into a Remedial Design/Remedial Action ("RD/RA") consent decree with EPA which is approved and entered by the United States District Court in Tampa, Florida.

7. Although Respondents who select Menu Option 1 will pay less money to settle now, they also will assume the risk that EPA may later decide that the Floridan Aquifer needs to be remediated and/or that chemical precipitation will be required in one or both Aquifers. If EPA determines that one or more of the worst-case scenario remedial actions are necessary, and that as a result, the Peak Oil PRPs' costs of Site cleanup will increase above the \$10,027,019 estimated cost for the best-case scenario, EPA, in its discretion, is authorized to require Respondents who have selected Menu Option 1 to pay additional money under this Consent Order. In such event, EPA may issue a written demand for additional payment to Respondents who have selected Menu Option 1. By signing this Consent Order, Respondents who select Menu Option 1 agree that they will make such additional payments to EPA as instructed in EPA's demand letter. The additional payments will be based on the worst-case dollar/gallon figure of \$5.52 per gallon. For example, if a Respondent's volume is 2,000

gallons, payment under the best-case scenario would be 2,000 gallons x \$4.02 = \$8,040.00. If a worst-case scenario arises, and EPA demands additional payment from that Respondent, the Respondent's payment would be calculated by taking the difference between the best-case per/gallon cost (\$4.02) and the worst-case per/gallon cost (\$5.52), or \$1.50, and multiplying it by the number of gallons. Therefore, the Respondent in this example would be required to pay an additional amount as follows: 2000 gallons x \$1.50 = \$3,000.00.

8. If a Respondent fails to comply with EPA's demand for additional payment as set forth in Paragraph 7, the Respondent would be in violation of the Consent Order and subject to the assessment of civil penalties as set forth in Section VI, Paragraph 10. Further, in the event of such nonpayment, and notwithstanding any other provision of this Consent Order, the United States, including EPA, reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, the right to issue administrative orders requiring the Respondent to undertake the additional cleanup activities, and the right to institute judicial proceedings seeking to compel that individual Respondent to reimburse EPA for a higher share of past and future costs than is being reimbursed by that individual PRP under this Consent Order. Further, Respondents who select Menu Option 1 and are later required by EPA to pay additional sums under a worst-case scenario but fail to do so, would not be protected from contribution actions by

other PRPs for reimbursement of costs incurred by those PRPs in performing such worst-case remedial work.

9. The settlement Menu Option selected by each Respondent will affect the scope of EPA's covenant not to sue, as well as the reservations of rights and contribution protection (Section VI, Paragraphs 12, 14, and 20) as they pertain to each Respondent. Respondents who select Menu Option 2 (the worst-case scenario payment) will receive a broader covenant not to sue and contribution protection than those that select Menu Option 1 (the best-case scenario payment).

#### VII. CIVIL PENALTIES

10. In addition to any other remedies or sanctions available to EPA, any Respondent who fails or refuses to comply with any term or condition of this Consent Order shall be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per day for each failure or refusal to comply pursuant to Section 122(l) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(l).

#### VIII. CERTIFICATION OF RESPONDENTS

11. By signing this Consent Order, each Respondent certifies individually that in its effort to determine the total volume of waste oil and hazardous substances it arranged to send to the Peak Oil Site, it has diligently conducted a thorough search of all of its pertinent available records and documents and has exhausted all reasonable means to obtain pertinent information from knowledgeable individuals (including, but not limited to, current and former officers, directors, employees,

contractors or agents). Each Respondent further certifies individually that it has fully and accurately disclosed to EPA all records, documents and information currently in its possession, or in the possession of its officers, directors, employees, contractors or agents, which relate in any way to the generation, treatment, transportation, storage or disposal of waste oil and hazardous substances which it arranged to send to the Peak Oil Site. Each Respondent further acknowledges that it has been given an opportunity to dispute its volume prior to entering into this Consent Order, and further certifies individually, that to the best of its knowledge, the total volume (in gallons) attributed to it in the De Minimis Cost Matrix (Attachment B) is accurate. Each Respondent further certifies individually that it has fully and accurately complied with any and all EPA requests for information pursuant to Sections 104(e) and 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9604(e) and 9622(e), and Section 3007 of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6927. Provision of false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations to the United States may subject a Respondent to criminal penalties pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 1001.

#### IX. COVENANTS BY EPA

12. In consideration of the payments that will be made by the Respondents under the terms of this Consent Order, and except as specifically provided in Section VI, Paragraphs 8, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of this Consent Order, EPA covenants not to sue any Respondent or take administrative action against any Respondent

pursuant to Sections 106(a) or 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(a) or 9607(a), and Section 7003 of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6973, relating to the Matters Addressed in this Consent Order. With respect to present and future liability, these covenants shall take effect with respect to each Respondent upon the receipt of the payments from that Respondent as required by Section VI, Paragraph 1 (and as may be required by Section VI, Paragraphs 8, 15, and 16) of this Consent Order. With respect to each Respondent, these covenants are conditioned upon the complete and satisfactory performance by that Respondent of its obligations under this Consent Order, and valid certification as set out in Section VI, Paragraph 11. These covenants extend only to the Respondents and do not extend to any other person or entity.

X. COVENANTS BY RESPONDENTS

13. The Respondents covenant and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against the United States or any of its agencies or its contractors or employees with respect to the Matters Addressed in this Consent Order, including, but not limited to, any direct or indirect claim for reimbursement from the Hazardous Substances Superfund (established pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 9507) through Sections 106(b)(2), 111, 112 or 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(b)(2), 9611, 9612 or 9613, or any other provision of law, or any claims arising out of response activities at the Site. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be deemed to constitute preauthorization of a

claim within the meaning of Section 111 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9611, or 40 C.F.R. § 300.700(d).

#### XI. RESERVATIONS OF RIGHTS

14. The covenants by EPA set forth in Section VI, Paragraph 12, of this Consent Order do not pertain to any matters other than those expressly specified in Paragraph 12. The United States, including EPA, reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, all rights against each Respondent with respect to all other matters, including but not limited to the following:

- a) claims based on a failure to make the payments required by Section VI, Paragraphs 1, 8, 15 and 16 of this Consent Order;
- b) criminal liability;
- c) liability for damages for injury to, destruction of, or loss of natural resources.

15. If information not known to EPA as of the effective date of this Consent Order is discovered which indicates that the volume of waste oil contributed to the Site by any individual Respondent exceeds the volume which Respondent has certified as accurate under this Consent Order, EPA, in its discretion, may require that Respondent to make further payments to account for the additional volume. EPA will calculate additional payment amounts using the same payment formula that was utilized in determining the Respondent's initial payment amount (approximately \$4.02/gallon for the best-case scenario,

approximately \$5.52/gallon for the worst-case scenario). By signing this Consent Order, each Respondent agrees to pay the additional sum upon demand by EPA. If a Respondent fails to comply with EPA's demand for payment, the Respondent would be in violation of the Consent Order and subject to the assessment of civil penalties as set forth in Section VI, Paragraph 10. Further, in the event of such nonpayment, and notwithstanding any other provision of this Consent Order, the United States, including EPA, reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, the right to institute judicial proceedings seeking to compel that individual Respondent to reimburse EPA for a higher share of past and future costs than is being reimbursed by that individual PRP under this Consent Order. Also, any Respondent who fails to comply with EPA's demand for additional payment would not be protected from contribution actions by other PRPs who are performing the RD/RA for reimbursement of additional funding above the amount previously paid by Respondent pursuant to this Consent Order.

16. If information not known to EPA as of the effective date of this Consent Order is discovered which indicates that the volume of waste oil contributed to the Site by any individual Respondent exceeds 22,000 gallons, EPA, in its discretion, may determine that the Respondent is no longer eligible for a de minimis settlement. If EPA determines that Respondent is no longer eligible for a de minimis settlement, and notwithstanding any other provision of this Consent Order, the United States,

including EPA, reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, the right to institute judicial proceedings or to issue an administrative order seeking to compel that individual Respondent (1) to perform response actions relating to the Site, and (2) to reimburse the United States, including EPA, for additional costs of response at the Site. Further, if EPA determines that a Respondent is no longer eligible for a de minimis settlement, PRPs conducting the RD/RA would not be precluded from bringing a contribution action against the Respondent seeking additional funding in an amount greater than that submitted by the Respondent pursuant to this de minimis Consent Order.

17. If EPA determines that any Respondent's certification as to its total volume of waste oil sent to the Site was knowingly or deliberately false, EPA, in its discretion, may determine that the Respondent is no longer be eligible for a de minimis settlement, and that this Consent Order shall be void ab initio as to that Respondent. In such event, such Respondent shall no longer be entitled to the covenant not to sue and contribution protection afforded under this Consent Order, and shall be potentially subject to criminal sanctions as described in Section VI, Paragraph 11.

XII. EFFECT OF SETTLEMENT: CONTRIBUTION PROTECTION

18. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to create any rights in, or grant any cause of action to, any person not a party to this Consent Order. The preceding sentence shall

not be construed to waive or nullify any rights that any person not a signatory to this Consent Order may have under applicable law. The United States, including EPA, and the Respondents each reserve any and all rights (including, but not limited to, any right to contribution), defenses, claims, demands, and causes of action which each party may have with respect to any matter, transaction, or occurrence relating in any way to the Site against any person not a party hereto.

19. EPA and the Respondents agree that the actions undertaken by the Respondents in accordance with this Consent Order do not constitute an admission of any liability by any Respondent. The Respondents do not admit and retain the right to controvert in any subsequent proceedings, other than proceedings to implement or enforce this Consent Order, the validity of the Statement of Facts or Determinations contained in this Consent Order.

20. With regard to claims for contribution against each Respondent for Matters Addressed by this Consent Order (except as otherwise provided in Section VI, Paragraphs 8, 15, 16, and 17), EPA and Respondents agree that each Respondent is entitled, as of the date of this Consent Order, to such protection from contribution actions or claims as is provided by Sections 113(f)(2) and 122(g)(5) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613(f)(2) and 9622(g)(5). Such protection with respect to each Respondent is conditioned upon that Respondent's compliance with the requirements of this Consent Order.

XIII. PARTIES BOUND

21. This Consent Order shall apply to and be binding upon EPA, and the Respondents and their heirs, successors and assigns. Any change in ownership or corporate status of a Respondent including, but not limited to, any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall in no way alter each Respondent's responsibilities under this Consent Order. Each signatory to this Consent Order represents that he or she is fully authorized to enter into the terms and conditions of this Consent Order and to bind legally the Respondent which he or she represents.

XIV. PUBLIC COMMENT

22. This Consent Order shall be subject to a thirty-day public comment period pursuant to Section 122(i) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i). In accordance with Section 122(i)(3) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i)(3), EPA may withdraw or modify consent to this Consent Order if comments received disclose facts or considerations which indicate that this Consent Order is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate.

XV. ATTORNEY GENERAL APPROVAL

23. The Attorney General or her designee has issued prior written approval of the settlement embodied in this Consent Order in accordance with Section 122(g)(4) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(4).

XVI. EFFECTIVE DATE

24. The effective date of this Consent Order shall be the date upon which EPA issues written notice to the Respondents that

the public comment period pursuant to Section VI, Paragraph 22, of this Consent Order has closed and that comments received if any, do not require modification of or EPA withdrawal from this Consent Order, and that EPA has finalized this Consent Order.

NO PAYMENTS ARE TO BE MADE BY THE RESPONDENTS UNTIL AFTER RECEIPT OF WRITTEN NOTICE FROM EPA THAT THE CONSENT ORDER HAS BEEN FINALIZED. PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF EPA'S WRITTEN NOTICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION VI, PARAGRAPH 1.

XVII. ATTACHMENTS

25. The following Attachments are attached to and incorporated into this Consent Order:

"Attachment A" contains a list of the Respondents who have signed this Consent Order.

"Attachment B" is the De Minimis Cost Matrix including the alphabetized list of de minimis PRPs, and the cost share and premium for each de minimis PRP under Menu Option 1 and Menu Option 2.

## PAYMENT FORMULA

### STEP 1: DETERMINATION OF WASTE OIL VOLUME AT SITE:

The first step to calculate the payment amount for each de minimis PRP was to establish a base volume to be used in determining each PRP's allocation ratio to be applied to the costs described below for work completed at the Site and future work to be performed at the Site.

The base volume represents gallons of waste oil sent to the Site by all identified, apparently viable, non-bankrupt PRPs for which EPA has been able to obtain a verified address.

This total base volume used to determine each de minimis PRPs payment amount is 7,137,326 gallons.

### STEP 2: COSTS INCURRED & ESTIMATED FUTURE COSTS AT THE SITE:

Each de minimis PRP's allocation ratio has been applied to the following costs at the Site:
