## Tips

- Always use Drupal WebCMS, the Agency Standard to build your transformed content.
- Drupal WebCMS operates under a FLAT structure and does not use nested directories.
  - Publishes to [www2.epa.gov/area-name](http://www2.epa.gov/area-name) [for home pages]
  - [www2.epa.gov/areaname/your-title-here](http://www2.epa.gov/areaname/your-title-here) [for all other pages]
- When assigning titles to your pages, be as specific as possible.
  - Example: Do not name a page Basic-Info. Instead be more specific: Lead-Basic-Info or Basic Information about Lead.
- Drupal WebCMS stores information in a database.
  - Content cannot be moved from folder to folder using a FTP program.
- Check out our release notes. They are updated with new features (quarterly).
