Re: Referral of Title VI Administrative Complaint

Dear Ms. Franklin-Thomas:

On January 13, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Office of Civil Rights (OCR) received a complaint from an Alabama resident that he had allegedly been discriminated against by the Alabama Department of Finance, the Alabama Department of Public Health, the Alabama Department of Economic & Community Affairs, the Alabama Department of Human Services, the Alabama State Personnel Department, the Alabama Public Service Commission, and the Alabama Department of Transportation, in violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (Title VI), 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d *et seq.*, and EPA's nondiscrimination regulations implementing Title VI found at 40 C.F.R. Part 7. The complaint alleged that the complainant was fired from a position at the Alabama Public Service Commission on April 9, 2009, based on having a disability and in retaliation for being a whistleblower about a "pattern of wrongdoings" in several agencies.

OCR's jurisdictional requirements state that to be accepted for investigation the complaint must be filed against a recipient of EPA assistance that allegedly committed the discriminatory act(s). EPA does not provide assistance to either the Alabama State Personnel Department or the Alabama Public Service Commission, and therefore, EPA lacks jurisdiction to investigate these allegations.

In addition, because the allegations in this complaint stem from issues related to employment, we are referring this complaint to your agency for review and action. Copies of the

complaint, the request for clarification, and the complainant's response to the request for clarification are enclosed.
