New Security Procedures for Contractors

- Parity between federal & non federal employees
- Effective 1 Dec 2011 for all new contracts
 - Does not apply to existing contracts or options
- For unescorted routine access six months or less:
 - Employees must be fingerprinted with favorable results
- For unescorted routine access more than six months:
 - Employees must be fingerprinted with favorable results
 - All investigative paperwork submitted & questions answered
- Specific details will be provided in PWS & by CORs
- Work cannot start until all security procedures are met!

Organizational Conflicts of Interest

WOSB Program

- Effective April 1, 2011
- Added FAR 19.15 WOSB Program
- 5% WOSB Statutory Goal
- Agencies can Restrict Competition
 - EDWOSB if NAICs code is underrepresented
 - WOSB if NAICS code is substantially underrepresented

8A Sole Source Justification

- Effective March 16, 2011
- 8A Sole Source over \$20M Requires Justification
 - Must be in writing
 - Must be approved by official at FAR 6.304
 - Must be made public after award

Socioeconomic Program Parity

Effective March 16, 2011

 No Order of Priority among 8A, HUBZone or SDVOSB

 Contracting Officers may use discretion in setting aside to any of the above categories

Repeal of Small Bus Competitive Demonstration

Effective Jan 31, 2011

 Deletes FAR 19.10 Small Business Competitive Demonstration Program

HUBZone Program Revisions

- Effective Jan 12, 2011
- Must be HUBZone small business concern at time of offer AND time of award

- Construction--50% of cost of contract must be for HUBZone contractor employees
 - Can be Prime or Sub
 - Can be waived in some circumstances

SDB Self Certification

• Effective Dec 13, 2010

- Subcontractors can Self Represent SDB Status
- Prime may Rely on Sub's Written Representation
- Contractor, Contracting Officer or any other
 Interested Party can challenge by filing a protest

SB Accelerated Payments

- Effective Sep 14, 2011
- OMB Policy Letter M-11-32
- Small Businesses Now Paid Within 15 Days
 - Only a goal and only when practicable
 - Must receive proper documentation
 - Must verify goods or services have been received
- Does not change required payment date or interest under Prompt Payment Act

Suspension & Debarment

• Effective Dec 13, 2010

 FAR 9.405 and 52.209-6 no longer apply to subcontracts for Commercially Available Off the Shelf Items

 For Commercial items, the requirements of 52.209-6 now only applies to first tier subs

Sustainable Acquisition

- Effective May 31, 2011
- New FAR Subpart 23.1, Sustainable Acquisition
- 95% of New Contract Actions Must Use Products that are:
 - Energy Efficient
 - Water Efficient
 - Biobased
 - Environmentally Preferable
 - Non Ozone Depleting

Standard Form 26 Award/Contract

- Effective May 2, 2011
- Clarifies use Of Blocks 17 & 18 of SF 26
 - Block 17 is for Negotiated Contracts
 - Requires contractors to sign and return
 - Block 18 is for Sealed Bids
 - Contractor not required to sign—offer becomes award

Multiple Award Contracts

- Effective May 6, 2011
- FAR 8.405-1 & 8.405-2 Amended
 - Must receive 3 bids for FSS orders above SAT
- FAR 8.405-3 Amended
 - Establishes preference for multiple award BPAs under FSS
 - Establishes competition requirements for placing orders under FSS BPAs

FAPIIS

- Effective Jan 24, 2011
- FAPIIS info now publicly available
 - Past performance reviews are excluded
- Government must post the following to FAPIIS:
 - Non-responsibility determinations
 - Terminations for default or cause
 - Defective pricing determinations
- Contractors must post the following to FAPIIS:
 - Criminal, civil and administrative proceedings for which the contractor was found at fault

Notification of Employee Rights

- Effective Dec 13, 2010
- New FAR Subpart 22.16, Notification of Employee Rights under the National Labor Relations Act
- Contractors & subs required to post notice of employee rights under federal labor laws

Proposed FAR Cases

- Service Contracts Reporting Requirements
 - Will create FAR 4.16, Service Contracts Inventory
 - Will create new Service Contract Reporting Portal
- Documenting Contractor Performance
 - CPARS govt wide with standard evaluation factors and ratings
 - EPA's new CPAR guidance effective Oct 3, 2011
- Biobased Procurements
 - Will require contractors to report biobased products purchased under service and constructions contracts
- Organizations Conflicts of Interest (OCI)
 - Revamps OCI guidance; provides standard clauses
- Privacy Training
 - Mandatory training for contractors that handle or access PII
