The city of Clarsville, Tennessee was discovered to be out of compliance with Title VI laws, rules and regulations by the Tennessee Title VI Compliance Commission.

The city has refused to comply with the commission's ruling. The city of Clarksville has also lost three civil rights and discrimination lawsuits in federal court. The city has settled two other civil rights and discrimination lawsuits filed against them out of court.

There is also a Title VI lawsuit filed against the city of Clarksville and Montgomery County presently in federal court.

I am officially informing the EPA of these civil rights and discrimination lawsuits filed against the city of Clarksville and Montgomery County.

The United States Department of Transportation will perform a Title VI Compliance Audit and Review on the city of Clarksville and the Tennessee Department of Transportation.

According to your own rules and regulations any recipient or subrecipient of federal funds must inform EPA of pending or ongoing lawsuits against them. They must also report any findings or rulings of noncompliance violations against them.

Has the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation or the city of Clarksville and Montgomery County informed EPA officials of these civil rights and discrimination lawsuits?
