## **Restoration Listening Sessions**

Ocean Conservancy, in association with the Environmental Protection Agency, a member of the Gulf Coast Ecosystem Restoration Council, invites you to attend an upcoming series of Listening Sessions to discuss Gulf restoration priorities and opportunities provided by a portion of the RESTORE Act.

Approximately \$150-\$180 million is currently available to restore the Gulf from the BP Deepwater Horizon oil disaster. Guided by a Comprehensive Plan, Gulf Coast Ecosystem Restoration Council members have proposed [50 restoration projects and programs](#) to be considered on a Draft Funded Priorities List.
