Camp Minden - LANG

Emergency Notification

Begins with a 911 call; triggers a standard operation of dispatch protocol

Emergency Exercise

Annual practicing of response with local response agencies

Support Function

During an emergency, LANG is a support agency to responders

Accountability

Tenant Evac and Accountability – Explosive Information - YCP

UNRELATED TO M6 ISSUE

Explosive Testing

Explosive testing is regularly conducted by tenants as it has been for years. Local response agencies are notified in advance of such testing.

Controlled Forestry Burning

Controlled forestry burning is conducted annually for fire prevention and wildlife management. Response agencies and the media are notified in advance. These burns do NOT take place in explosive storage areas.

M6 SITUATIONAL REPORT

Storage Bunkers

Media aerial photos are OLD. ALL M6 has been in bunkers since 2013.

Bunker Locations

Bunker areas are located in very remote areas of the facility, away from residential areas, schools, prison, tenants, administration buildings, and YCP.
