JUDGMENT ON THE AMENDMENT TO THE DECLARATION OF TAKING NO. 9, TRACT D-49

Considering the condemnation petition, as supplemented and amended, the amendment to the declaration of taking dated August 14, 1942, the motion filed by the former land owners, William C. Fulbright, William C. Fulbright, Jr., Helen Fulbright Smith, Mildred Fulbright LeFevé, and Beatrice Fulbright, a minor, and concurred in by the United States of America, which motion was filed on August 17, 1942, the statutes in such cases made and provided and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court:

I.

That the description in Tract D-49 in declaration of taking No. 9 should be amended so as to delete therefrom the following described property, to-wit::

NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6 lying East of oil Minden-Doyline Road;

N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6; and NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5 lying Northwest of Dorcheat Bayou, all in Township 18 North, Range 9 West in Webster Parish, Louisiana.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the judgment on the declaration of taking NO. 9 as to Tract D-49, be amended so as to describe said Tract D-49 as follows, to-wit:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T. 18 N. R. 10 W.; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 19 N. R. 10 W.; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 19 N. R. 10 W.; that part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 19 N. R. 10 W., lying South of L. & A. R. R., containing 8.45 acres; all that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 19 N. R. 10 W., lying South of L. & A. R. R., containing 0.18 acres; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 19 N. R. 9 W.; that part of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 19 N. R. 9 W., West of Minden-Doyline road, 4.85 acres; all that part of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 19 N. R. 9 W.,

West of Minden-Doyline Road 1.12 acres;

Also, a portion of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T. 18 N. R. 9 W., lying West of the Minden-Doyline road except 2 acres described as follows: Beginning at a point where the Westerly right of way of the old Minden-Doyline road intersects the South line of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 6, thence Northeast along the said right of way line 140 yards, thence West 70 yards, thence Southwesterly, parallel with said road 140 yards, thence East 70 yards to point of beginning, containing 280 acres, more or less.

All of the above described lands are situated in the Parish of Webster, State of Louisiana.
