NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUE

RE: Letter of Intent to Sue

Dear Environmental Protection Agency Legal Department and Connie and Gary Bentz, LLP:

This letter serves as a formal notice of my intent, to file a lawsuit against the Environmental Protection Agency and its agent Annie Holt. I also intend to sue, Gary and Connie Bentz in both their professional and personal capacities.

In July -2012 I filed a complaint against my landlord for illegal exposure and failure to follow EPA guidelines. I was told I had a legitimate complaint. I have made numerous attempts to resolve this matter with no success. I have waited nearly a year and I am being refused information, FIOA data, and any rights

whatsoever even though I submitted strict proof and these acts go against EPA's own Policy(ies).

EPA:

If you wish to resolve this matter without court action, to resolve the complaint against Connie and Gary Bentz for what they did to N'Jai when they illegally and deliberately exposed her to lead and mole dust, did not give her information pamphlets on lead and mole dusts as required by the EPA, making false accusations that there was no lead dust and/or mole, and then defamed and slandered N'Jai in retaliation for exerting her right to file an EPA complaint. The EPA did not and refused to act or to exert any administrative remedy whatsoever. I hope to hear from you within [30 days]. If I do not hear from your company, I will initiate a lawsuit.

As to Connie and Gary Bentz, and Bentz CBA LLC.,

If you wish to resolve this matter without court action, to resolve the complaint against both Connie and Gary Bentz [In professional and personal capacities] for what you did to N'Jai when you (1) illegally and deliberately exposed her to lead and mole dust, (2) did not give her information pamphlets on lead and mole dusts as required by the EPA, (3) made false and inaccurate statements about lead and mole, and then (4) defamed and slandered N'Jai in retaliation for exerting her right to file an EPA complaint. I hope to hear from you within [30 days]. If I do not hear from your company, I will initiate a lawsuit.
