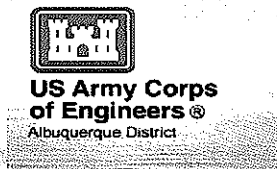



Ready for Reuse Certificate

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 together have determined that the former Atlas Missile Silo Site 5 surface property, located in Chaves County, approximately 35 miles east of Roswell, New Mexico, on the north side of U.S. Highway 380, is Ready for Reuse. A Ready for Reuse Determination is an acknowledgement that environmental conditions on the surface property are protective for its current and anticipated future use as an industrial operation.
