
TIER II ACUTE AND CHRONIC AQUATIC LIFE VALUES

4-METHYLPHENOL

CAS RN: 106-44-5

Water Solubility: <0.1 g/100 mL at 21 C

Standard

The procedures described in the Tier II methodology indicate that, except possibly where a locally important species is very sensitive, aquatic organisms should not be affected unacceptably if the four (4) day average concentration of 4-methylphenol does not exceed 53 µg/L more than once every three (3) years on the average and if the one (1) hour average concentration does not exceed 480 µg/L more than once every three (3) years on the average.

Calculations

Acute Aquatic Life:

SAV = lowest GMAV/SAF

Lowest GMAV = $7,700 \mu g/L$ SAF = 8.0

 $SAV = 7,700/8.0 = 962.5 \mu g/L$

 $SMC = SAV/2 = 962.5/2 = 480 \mu g/L$

Chronic Aquatic Life:

SCV = SAV/SACR

SACR = 18

 $SCV = 962.5/18 = 53 \mu g/L$
