

Standard

The human health noncancer chlorodibromomethane criterion for drinking water sources is 570 μ g/L. The human health noncancer criterion for nondrinking water sources is 12,000 μ g/L.

BAF predicted based on Log K_{ow} (from Stephan 1993) Log K_{ow} = 2.232 (CLOGP), K_{ow} = 170.6 Trophic level 3 FCM = 1.005; trophic level 4 FCM = 1.000

$$f_{fd} = 1/(1+(0.00000024 \text{ kg/L})(K_{ow})) = 1.00$$

Baseline BAF_{T3} = (FCM)(K_{ow}) = (1.005)(170.6) = 171.5

Baseline BAF_{T4} = (1.000)(170.6) = 170.6

Human health BAF_{T3} = [(171.5)(0.0182)+1](1.00) = 4.120

Human health BAF_{T4} = [(170.6)(0.0310)+1](1.00) = 6.289

Critical Effect: Hepatic lesions

$$ADE = \frac{NOAEL}{UF} = \frac{21.4 \text{ mg/kg-day}}{1000} = 0.0214 \text{ mg/kg/d}$$

Calculation of Criteria:

Non Drinking Water HNC = [(0.0214)(70)(0.8)]/0.01+[(0.0036)(4.12)+(0.0114)(6.289)]

$$= 570 \mu g/L$$

Drinking Water HNC = [(0.0214)(70)(0.8)]/2+[(0.0036)(4.12)+(0.0114)(6.289)]

$$= 12,000 \mu g/L$$
