Amending Subpart A of 40 CFR part 98: Reporting of Corporate Parent Information, NAICS Codes and Cogeneration

Overview

Background



- Signed by the Administrator on September 16, 2010.
- Adds to the General Provisions (subpart A) of 40 CFR part 98¹ the requirement to report corporate parent information, NAICS codes, and whether any reported emissions are from a cogeneration unit.
- Applies to all subparts under Part 98.
- Requires reporters to submit these additional data elements in the first annual GHG emissions report due to EPA on March 31, 2011 and in all future years.

¹ 40 CFR part 98 is the regulatory framework for the Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program (GHGRP).

Required Reporting Elements



Parent Company:

- The names and physical addresses of all of the facility/supplier's parent companies; and
- The percent ownership associated with each of the parent companies reported.

NAICS:

- At least one, and up to two, primary NAICS codes associated with the primary source(s) of revenue at the facility; and
- All additional NAICS codes associated with all other sources of revenue at the facility.

Cogeneration:

- Indicate whether reported emissions include emissions from a cogeneration unit (yes/no).
