SUMMARY

Per your request on January 14, 1977, I have contacted the following people on the question of whether a gray iron foundry would be considered subject to PSD review under 40 C.F.R. 52.21(d): Richard Biondi (DSSE), Dan DeRoeck (OAQPS), and Brian Beals. They, including myself, all agree that a gray iron foundry is not to be considered as one of the nineteen source categories subject to 52.21(d) (i.e., it is not an iron and steel mill nor an integral part of one).
