GIWiz offers quick, direct access to Green Infrastructure tools and resources. Users can produce customized reports that include links to the resources they want to utilize.



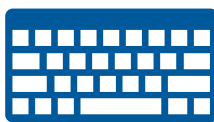
What is the Problem?

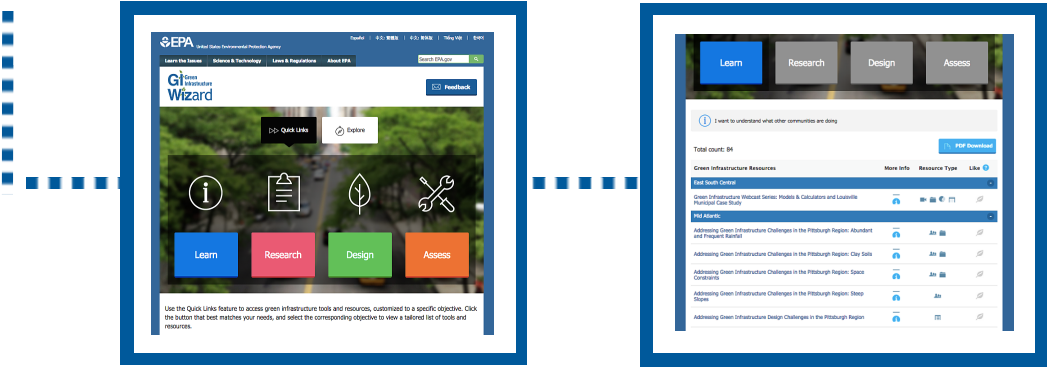
