PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The United States Environmental Protection Agency has prepared this proposed Permit Modification for the facility owned by W.R. Grace & Co.-Conn., (MDD074933961). EPA's proposed permit modification confirms EPA's determination that the permittee has completed corrective action obligation on a 58 acre parcel of the property identified as the GF Columbia Parcel and removes the parcel from the Facility and therefore is no longer subject to the requirements of the W.R. Grace & Co.-Conn Permit. In addition, this draft Permit Modification confirms EPA's determination that the groundwater contaminants were approaching groundwater cleanup endpoints.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Facility is located in Columbia, Maryland, northeast of Route 32 and north/northwest of Cedar Lane. The Facility consists of approximately 125 acres, including landscaped grassy areas; office, research and support buildings; two ponds, and wooded areas. The Middle Patuxent River is located just east of the Facility.

All comments will be considered in making the final Permit Modification

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the decision is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination.
