

How to Access the 2012 CGP NOI/LEW eNOI Application if You Have an Existing CDX Account

The electronic Notice of Intent (NOI) application for the 2012 Construction General Permit (CGP) and the Low Erosivity Waiver (LEW) is accessed through a new program in EPA's Central Data Exchange (CDX). The previous "SWENOI" program in CDX that you may have used to submit NOIs for the 2008 CGP and/or LEWs has been disabled and can no longer be used.

To submit an NOI for coverage under the 2012 CGP or to submit an LEW waiver form, you will need to add the 2012 CGP NOI/LEW eNOI application to your CDX account by doing the following:

Step 1. Log into your existing CDX account at <http://cdx.epa.gov>.

DISCLAIMER: Please make sure that the following settings are checked in your browser: 1) Use TLS 1.0 2) Enable native XMLHTTP. The system works with Internet Explorer versions 7 and 8, Google Chrome versions 9, 10, 11, and 12, and Mozilla Firefox versions 3.6 and 4.0.

Internet Explorer – Go to Tools > Internet Options > Advanced

Google Chrome (only need to select TLS 1.0 for this browser) – Go to Tools (picture located at upper right hand corner) > Options > Under the Hood > HTTPS/SSL

Mozilla Firefox (only need to select TLS 1.0 for this browser) – Go to Tools > Options > Advanced > Encryption
