Dear Ms. Goldberg:

I am writing to confirm the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) receipt of the petition submitted by you and a number of other organizations on August 4, 2011. Your petition was filed under Section 21 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) and requests that EPA take action under Section 4 to require that manufacturers and processors of oil and gas exploration or production (E&P) chemicals conduct toxicity testing of all E&P chemicals and identify all chemicals and mixtures tested. You also requested that the EPA take action under the TSCA Section 8 to require maintenance and submission of various records related to E&P chemicals.

EPA will respond to this petition in the 90-day time period provided by Section 21 of TSCA, which will be November 2, 2011.
