- Collection system controls (inflow removal; sewer rehabilitation; maximizing flow to the wastewater treatment plant; monitoring and real time control; sewer separation)
- Storage technologies (in-and off-line)
- Treatment technologies (high rate treatment; disinfection; floatables control; others)
