










Map of Community

- •Assessment of agricultural runoff in 2007 as response to Tribal Council inquiry.
- Discovered high traces of E-coli in various areas







CWA 319 Funding

- Received funding from EPA in October 2010
- Clean Water Act (CWA)319 Grant
- •Goal to identify pollution and organize prevention measures for nonpoint source pollution in irrigation ditches
