

### **The Honorable Ignacia S. Moreno**

**Ignacia S. Moreno** is a nationally recognized leader in the field of environmental and natural resources law and has practiced law for more than 25 years. She is the Chief Executive Officer and a Principal of The iMoreno Group, PLC, a law firm that offers legal services and strategic counseling on environmental and natural resources matters in the context of regulatory compliance, enforcement proceedings, litigation, business transactions, project development, government relations, and crisis management. The firm also offers advice and counsel on corporate, criminal defense, and immigration matters.

Ms. Moreno was unanimously confirmed by the United States Senate (93 to 0) and served as Assistant Attorney General for the Environment and Natural Resources Division of the United States Department of Justice from 2009 to 2013. She was recognized for her outstanding service, including her leadership of the Division's response to the Deepwater Horizon oil spill. Ms. Moreno is the first Latina to serve as Assistant Attorney General in the Division's 106-year history. She is a former Counsel for the Northeast/Midwest Regions and International at the General Electric Company, and has practiced law at two prominent Washington, D.C. law firms, including as a Partner. Ms. Moreno also served at the Department of Justice for seven years during the Clinton Administration.

Ms. Moreno currently serves on the National Board of Directors of the Trust for Public Land; the Advisory Board of the Institute for Policy Integrity at New York University School of Law; and the Board of Directors of Green Diversity Initiative (Green 2.0). She also serves as Chair of the Special Committee on State Bar Coordination and Engagement for the American Bar Association, Section of Environment, Energy, and Resources. Ms. Moreno has served as President of the Hispanic Bar Association of the District of Columbia and as General Counsel of the Hispanic National Bar Association. She was named as one of the Top 100 Green Leaders in the United States by *PODER Hispanic Magazine* in 2013 and as one of the 100 Most Influential Hispanics in the United States by *Hispanic Business Magazine* in 1995 and 2009.

Ms. Moreno received a Bachelor of Arts degree from New York University and a Juris Doctor degree from New York University School of Law. She was born in Cartagena, Colombia and grew up in New York City. She lives in McLean, Virginia with her husband and son.
