The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a second Five-Year Review of the Kim-Stan Landfill Superfund Site located in Selma, Alleghany County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. EPA's previous review conducted in 2010 found the cleanup remedy to be protective. Results of the current review will be available by December 2015.
