

EPA Reviews Cleanup Limestone Road Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a third Five-Year Review of the Limestone Road Superfund Site located approximately two miles southeast of Cumberland in Allegheny County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. Prior reviews have determined the cleanup remedy is protective. The results of this review will be available by January 2016.
