

EPA Reviews Cleanup Woodlawn Landfill Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a third Five-Year Review of the Woodlawn Landfill Superfund Site located in Cecil County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. Prior reviews have determined the cleanup remedy is protective. The property has since been redeveloped into a protected wildlife habitat called *New Beginnings – The Woodlawn Wildlife Area*. Results of the current review will be available by December 2015.
