


Surface Coating of Wood Building Products NESHAP (subpart QQQQ) Applicability Flowchart



Potentially regulated SIC (NAICS) codes include 2421, 2426, 2431, 2435, 2436, 2493, and 2499 (321211, 321212, 321219, 321911, 321918, and 321999). Applicability of codes ending in 99 is dependent on the final end use of the product.

¹A Wood Building Product is defined as any product that contains more than 50% (by weight) wood or wood fibers, excluding the weight of any glass components, and is used in the construction (interior or exterior) of a residential, commercial, or institutional building [63.4681(a)].

⁴Usage limit only applies to surface coating of wood building products. Do not include coating used on products that are not potentially subject to subpart QQQQ.

²You must determine your affected source's potential to emit HAPs by looking at all stationary emissions within your fence line, not just those operations covered by the Wood Building Products NESHAP. If the affected source's potential is greater than or equal to the 10/25 limit, the source is considered a major source of HAP emissions.

⁴Subpart DDDD is the Plywood and Composite Wood Products NESHAP.

⁵Subpart JJ is the Wood Furniture NESHAP.
