

Peter S. Gray is a Deputy Chief with the Federal Coordination and Compliance Section of the U.S. Department of Justice, Civil Rights Division. FCS is charged with ensuring consistent and effective enforcement government-wide of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and other civil rights laws applicable to recipients of federal financial assistance. FCS also conducts administrative investigations of allegations of violation of these laws by recipients of federal financial assistance from the Department of Justice. In addition, the Section has been assigned government-wide coordination responsibilities with respect to Executive Order 13166, “Improving Access to Services for Persons with Limited English Proficiency.” Prior to joining FCS, Mr. Gray worked for the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission’s Office of Legal Counsel and Office of Federal Operations; and as an employment attorney for a private law firm in Washington, D.C., and Stamford, CT.
