NOTICE OF PROCEEDING TO ASSESS A CLASS I CIVIL PENALTY AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

AGENCY: United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

ACTION: Notice of Proceeding to Assess a Class I Civil Penalty and Opportunity to Comment

SUMMARY: EPA is providing notice of a proceeding to assess a Class I civil penalty for alleged violations of the Clean Water Act (Act). EPA is also providing notice of opportunity to comment on the proposed penalty assessment.

Under 33 U.S.C. §1319(g), EPA is authorized to issue Orders assessing civil penalties for various violations of the Act. EPA may issue such Orders after the commencement of a Class I or Class II penalty proceeding. EPA provides Public Notice of the proceeding pursuant to 33 U.S.C. §1319(g)(4)(A).

Administrative civil penalty proceedings are conducted under EPA's Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders and the Revocation Termination or Suspension of Permits ("CROP"), 40 C.F.R. Part 22. The procedures through which the public may submit written comment on a proposed administrative penalty action or participate in an administrative penalty proceeding, and the procedures by which a Respondent may request a Hearing, are set forth in the CROP. The deadline for submitting public comment on this administrative civil penalty proceeding is thirty (30) days after issuance of this Public Notice.

On December 14, 2015, EPA commenced the following administrative action for the assessment of administrative civil penalties: In the matter of Mark Jahnke and Hemlock Valley Farm, LLC, a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation located at 3409 State Highway 28, Milford, New York 13807; Docket Number CWA-02-2016-3308; and served on Regional Hearing Clerk, Karen Maples, EPA Region 2, 290 Broadway, 16th Floor, New York, New York 10007, (212) 637-3247. The Complaint proposed a penalty of \$9,500 for failure to comply with provisions of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit for Stormwater Discharges for Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations, GP-04-02. Stormwater discharges from Respondent's facility discharges to a tributary to the Susquehanna River which is in the Chesapeake Bay watershed.
