AMENDMENT NO. 1

MATERIALS TRANSFER AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

NEDERLANDSE ORGANISATIE VOOR TOEGEPAST-NATUURWETENSCHAPPELIJK ONDERZOEK TNO (Netherlands Organization for Applied Research TNO)

AND

THE NATIONAL CENTER FOR COMPUTATIONAL TOXICOLOGY UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

This "Amendment No. 1" is entered into by and between Nederlandse Organisatie Voor Toegepast-Natuurweten-Schappelijk Onderzoek TNO (Netherlands Organization for Applied Research TNO), a legal entity by public law (i.e. the TNO-wet) which has its principal place of business at Schoemakerstraat 97, 2628 VK Delft, The Netherlands ("Recipient"), and the National Center for Computational Toxicology ("Provider") of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") under the authority of Title 15, United States Code ' 3710a, et seq. (commonly known as the Federal Technology Transfer Act of 1986).

WITNESSETH:

- A. WHEREAS, the Recipient and the Provider executed a Materials Transfer Agreement (656-11), effective April 17, 2011 ("Agreement");
- **B.** WHEREAS, the Recipient and the Provider want to amend and supplement the Agreement;
- C. WHEREAS, the Recipient and Provider want to extend the Agreement to allow for additional time to transfer data;
- **D. WHEREAS**, the Provider views its continued cooperation with the Recipient to be in furtherance of the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties amend and supplement the Agreement as follows:

- 1. Section 13 is amended to read: This Amendment No. 1 shall extend the term of this Agreement an additional 12 months from the original termination date of April 17, 2012, to a new termination date of April 17, 2013.
- 2. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force and effect.
