Amendment No. 2 to the 1995 Record of Decision and Responsiveness Summary Currently Available for Public Review

U.S. EPA recently completed a Record of Decision (ROD)
Amendment for the Standard Chlorine of Delaware, Inc.
Superfund Site, located in New Castle County, DE. The ROD Amendment modifies a small component of the Operable Unit 2 (OU-2) remedy for former waste pile soils at the Site. The amendment involves placing OU-2 waste pile soils under the Operable Unit 3 (OU-3) multilayer cap currently being constructed.

The selected remedy was chosen in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA), as amended, 42 USC §§9601 et seq., and with the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP), 40 CFR Part 300.

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OU-1 Five-Year Review and Upcoming Report to be Available for Public Review

U.S. EPA is currently conducting the second Five-Year Review (5YR) of the Standard Chlorine of Delaware, Inc. Superfund Site, Operable Unit 1 (OU-1) and OU-3. EPA inspects Superfund sites regularly to help ensure that cleanups remain protective of public health and the environment. The prior review determined the OU-1 cleanup remedy, addressing the interim groundwater, is protective. The OU-3 remedy is currently under construction. The 5YR Report with results of this review is due to be available July 2016.
