PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE: The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed decision (Statement of Basis) for environmental remediation at the Former Kop-Flex Facility (Kop-Flex), (MDD043373935) under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 provisions of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: Kop-Flex is located on approximately 25 acres on Harmans Road, in Hanover, Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Operations ceased in late 2012 and all equipment and machine lines were removed. Kop-Flex formerly manufactured flexible couplings for mechanical power transmission.

INFORMATION AVAILABLE: The Administrative Record contains all the documents which EPA considered or relied upon in selecting the proposed remedies.
