

RE: Recommendations for NO<sub>2</sub> nonattainment areas in Kentucky

Dear Ms. Fleming:

In accordance with Section 107 (d)(1)(A) of the Clean Air Act, states must submit to U.S. EPA, within one year following promulgation of a new or revised National Ambient Air Quality Standard, a list of all areas in the state, recommending designations for each as attainment, nonattainment, or unclassifiable with respect to a new or revised standard for a pollutant.

In a letter dated November 12, 2010, I was notified that proposed designations for Kentucky are due January 25, 2011, for the new 1-hour primary standard for nitrogen dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>), which is 100 parts per billion (3-year average of the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile daily maximum 1-hour concentration)(75 FR 6474, February 9, 2010). Accordingly, we must submit initial NO<sub>2</sub> designation recommendations to EPA no later than January 2011. If the Administrator intends to modify any state's recommendation, the EPA will notify us no later than 120 days prior to designations in January 2012. If we believe the Administrator's modification is inappropriate, we will have an opportunity to demonstrate why we believe that our recommendation is more appropriate before designations are finalized.

The values of the 98<sup>th</sup> percentiles of the NO<sub>2</sub> monitors in Kentucky are listed in the table on the following page.

As can be seen, the average of the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile at all monitors is below the standard of 100 parts per billion: therefore these areas in Kentucky comply with the standard and should be designated as attainment for the NO<sub>2</sub> standard, with the remainder of the state designated as attainment/unclassifiable.
