

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

Berks Sand Pit Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Berks Sand Pit Superfund Site located in Longswamp Township. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. EPA's prior review of the site in 2011 confirmed the remedy was protective of public health and the environment. Additionally, a pilot study is being conducted to treat remaining groundwater contamination. EPA will modify the site's remedy if the injections prove effective in removing remaining contamination.
