

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

Mill Creek Dump Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Mill Creek Dump Superfund Site located in Erie. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. EPA's last review of the site in 2011 determined that while the remedy was protective, more testing was needed to make a long-term protectiveness determination. Since then, additional tests have been conducted, with detailed test results and a protectiveness determination available September 2016.
