Dear Mr. Adams:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is in receipt of your April 15, 2013 letter on behalf of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership, Enbridge Pipelines (Lakehead) L.L.C., Enbridge Pipelines (Wisconsin), and Enbridge Energy Partners, L.P. (herein collectively referred to as "Enbridge"), in which you request a change to paragraph 46.a of U.S.EPA's March 14, 2013 Administrative Order (Order). Paragraph 46.a of the Order requires that Enbridge reinstall the E-4.0 containment system in accordance with the 2012 Morrow Lake Delta Containment Strategy Design and Engineering Considerations Technical Memorandum as approved by U.S. EPA on June 26, 2012. Specifically, you request that U.S. EPA approve reducing the E-4.0 containment structure from six (6) boom locations to four (4) boom locations by eliminating Location A and Location B.

U.S. EPA hereby approves Enbridge's request.
