

#### **EPA Recommended Specifications Standards and Ecolabels**

EPA's Interim Recommendations are based on specifications, environmental performance standards and ecolabels selected and utilized by federal agencies to assist in their procurement of environmentally preferable products and services. Currently, the interim recommendations include specifications, standards and ecolabels from the Department of Energy's (DOE's) FY16 Priority Products List and the General Services Administration's (GSA's) Key Sustainable Products. DOE and GSA Public Buildings Service have identified specifications, standards and ecolabels for products that meet federal statutory requirements, have verified sustainability attributes, are readily available in the market, and meet cost and performance needs.

DOE's FY15 Priority Products List and GSA's Key Sustainability Products can be viewed on GSA's Green Procurement Compilation. Further information about the evaluation processes used by these Agencies to select these specifications, standards and ecolabels is available in the DOE's background and evaluation process document and the GSA Public Buildings Service's background and evaluation process document.

In some cases DOE and GSA Public Buildings Service have identified different specifications, standards and ecolabels for a specific product category. After consultation with GSA Public Buildings Service and DOE, EPA chose to utilize specifications, standards and ecolabels identified by GSA in those instances because they are required for GSA Public Buildings Service procurement while DOE's Priority Products List is used on a voluntary basis for DOE procurement. The relevant statutory sustainable procurement requirements and federal ecolabels that apply to each product and service category are included in the chart alongside the EPA Interim Recommendations in order to clarify Executive Order direction for federal purchasers. EPA has also revised some recommendations to address government-wide considerations. For most product categories, EPA's Interim Recommendations do not include specifications. In instances where there was known potential for limited product availability related to a particular standard or ecolabel, specifications were included.

EPA's Interim Recommendations do not include a comprehensive list of all product and service categories with federal statutory sustainable procurement requirements or relevant federal ecolabels. *Instructions:* If you do not already have a registered account <u>visit UL to create one</u>. Anyone with a .gov email address will gain access to the standard free of charge. Once the account is created follow the instructions below:

- Click the red "Purchase Options" button. It will take you to a new page, select "Secure PDF" with no fee, then click the red "Add to Cart" button.
