

# EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

## Ryeland Road Arsenic Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Ryeland Road Arsenic Superfund Site located in Heidelberg Township, Bucks County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. EPA's last review of the site conducted in 2011 determined that the remedy was protective; however, more testing was needed to make a long-term effectiveness determination. Since then, additional tests have been conducted, with test results and a protectiveness determination available September 2016.
