**PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE:** The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed decision of Corrective Action Complete with Controls under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (RCRA), for the former Koppers Company, Inc. facility (Facility) located at 15 Plum Street, Verona, Pennsylvania.

**FACILITY DESCRIPTION:** The Facility was known as the Verona Science and Technology Center and was used for research and development work of various industrial products. The former Facility has since been sold to Pearson, Inc. who leases the majority of the site to the Aloma Shim and Manufacturing Company who manufactures precision custom shims, alignment devices, and accessories.

**COMMENT PROCESS:** Persons wishing to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30 day comment period ending August 9, 2016. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Khai M. Dao, as listed above, and must be received prior to August 9, 2016. All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

**FINAL DECISION:** EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the decision is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the final decision is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new decision and will reopen the comment period.
