



## Top 30 College & University (as of July 25, 2016)

The Top 30 College & University list represents the largest green power users among higher education institutions within the Green Power Partnership. The combined green power use of these organizations amounts to nearly 2.2 billion kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to the electricity use of nearly 197,000 average American homes annually.
