

Area Source Boiler Notification of Compliance Status

In this document you will find out how to create and submit the Notification of Compliance Status under citation 63.11225(a)(4) by using the EPA's Compliance and Emissions Data Reporting Interface.

Before you can start this process you need to have already set up a user account with the Central Data Exchange (CDX) at the following website <https://cdx.epa.gov/>. After you have set up your CDX account you will need to register for the CEDRI data flow following the steps in the CEDRI users guide found on the area source boilers compliance assistance website (<http://www.epa.gov/boilercompliance/>).




