The Top 30 Retail list represents the largest green power users among retail partners within the Green Power Partnership. The combined green power usage of these organizations amounts to more than 4.6 billion kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to the electricity use of nearly 423,000 average American homes each year.
