Coordination of Triple Region Tribal IAQ Meeting:

Regions 6, 8 & 9 are in the beginning stages of planning this event. Some duties may include: assisting with setting up logistics, registration, advertising, and confirming speakers for the event.

Mission:

Inform the public of EPAs R8 IAQ information and develop a plan that outlines local resources the public can refer to as needed.

Specific duties may include, but are not limited, to the following:

- Research State and Local Landlord-Tenant Laws throughout R8 related to IAQ.
- Develop EPA R8 IAQ Guide and update R8 EPA Webpage
- Draft responses to public inquiries on IAQ using EPA recommendations. (emails, newsletters, phone calls)
- Social Media Posts (drafting Facebook and Twitter content, Regional and National)
- Event Planning
- Other As Needed
