Position Title: Intranet Designer

- Confident speaking skills in online-forums, meeting rooms, and virtual spaces such as webinars/screenshares.
- Basic understanding of HTML, CSS, Web concepts, and content management.
- Intermediate computing skills that include all common operating system platforms, software suites, and hardware (Microsoft, Apple, etc.).

Knowledge/Experience (optional, but a bonus):

- Proof of designing, building, or developing websites (one-pagers, e-brochure, e-commerce, corporate, etc.)
- Basic/Intermediate knowledge of Drupal CMS, PHP, MySQL, Javascript, JQuery, IIS, Windows Server 2012, Linux, Apache, Bootstrap Framework, Project Management software.
- Ability to provide similar products (website solutions) using varying methods/concepts.
- Understanding of social media APIs (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, and Flickr) for integration with web CMS platforms.
- Knowledge of Drupal 8.
