



## Top 30 K-12 Schools (as of February 8, 2017)

The Top 30 K-12 Schools list represents the largest green power users among K-12 school partners within the Green Power Partnership. The combined green power use of these organizations amounts to more than 110 million kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to the electricity use of more than 10,000 average American homes each year.
