Current Activities

Removal of waste under transportation and disposal (T&D) subcontract 4 commenced during the operational period which resulted in the removal of bulk liquids, bulk solids and flammable mixtures. In addition, personnel continued to break-down the interior warming cells, the on-site laboratory and empty containers.

The EPA continued to work with numerous partners including the Gloucester County Fire Marshal's Office, HazMat Team, NJDEP, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and local officials. NJDEP personnel continued weekly visitations. Security personnel continued to patrol the site during non-operational hours.

From June 2-6, 2014 two tankers a day were received for removal of bulk liquid waste. A total of 10 tankers transported approximately 60,000 gallons of waste to a treatment and disposal facility. Additionally, on June 2nd and 3rd solid waste was removed from the site. Two 20 yd³ roll-off containers holding drums and contents were sent off-site for disposal. On June 4, 2014 flammable materials such as sludge, liquid and paint were also shipped off-site for disposal. Combined, this represents the removal of approximately 640 containers during the operational period.

Site personnel continued to consolidate solid material remaining in containers following the removal of liquids. To deal with this residual material, the subcontractor met with site management. Various options were reviewed and based on

the consistency of the material, a high-power vacuum truck will be utilized for removing pumpable sludge and loose solids while tacky material and debris will be over-packed for T&D. Many drums with liquid wastes were found to be mixed with debris such as clothing, boots, tote tops, paper waste, plastic bottles and household trash.

Crews continued to breakdown spent totes, drums and tote cages. All metal from the tote cages is being segregated for recycling.

NJDEP continued to review options for the potential removal of used tires located on-site.

RST continued to provide air monitoring to ensure the safety of personnel and surrounding properties. Additionally, RST continued to manage the SCRIBE, FlexViewer and Response Manager databases.

Planned Response Activities

Collaboration between EPA, NJDEP, FWS, County, and local officials will continue throughout the removal activities of the Superior Barrel and Drum Site.

Additional waste identified in T&D subcontract 4 will continue to be removed. Crews will continue to consolidate solids found in the containers that have been voided of liquid waste. Spent drums and totes will continue to be processed, including cutting and crushing prior to disposal.

During the next operational period sludge waste, including residual from liquid waste, will be removed using a high-power vacuum truck. All remaining material that cannot be removed via vacuum truck will be consolidated and over-packed for disposal.

Options for removing TCE contaminated waste and remaining flammable liquids have been reviewed. Scheduling for the removal of this waste will occur in the next operational period. Options for the T&D of flammable sludge will continue to be reviewed for cost and time efficiency.

The sampling design for ground water and additional soil samples will continue to be developed. An on-site meeting is scheduled for June 10, 2014 to aid in finalizing a ground water well installation and sampling plan. Activities associated with the comprehensive assessment will commence in July 2014.

RST personnel will continue perimeter air monitoring until wastes have been removed from the facility.

Issues

The time frame for the second assessment at the site hinges on removal of on-site wastes as well as awarding of the RST contract, as the current contract expires on June 30, 2014.
