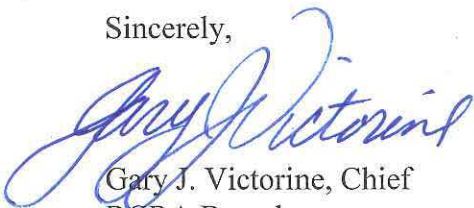
Dear Mr. Shuttleworth:

On August 21, 2015 a representative of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency inspected the Radio Materials Corporation facility located at 1095 East Summit Street in Attica, Indiana ("RMC"). The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate RMC's compliance with Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Section 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent dated March 1, 1999, Docket No. R8H-5-99-005, ("Consent Order").

As of this writing, based upon information available to EPA, our review of the inspection did not result in the detection of violations of any of the specific requirements of the Consent Order which were evaluated. This determination does not limit the applicability of the requirements evaluated, other hazardous waste regulations, or regulations under other environmental statutes.
