

Ocean Disposal of Marine Mammal Carcasses: Reporting Form for Government Entities and Stranding Agreement Holders (Section A of MPRSA General Permit)

Government entities as well as Marine Mammal Health and Stranding Response Program Stranding Agreement Holders (Stranding Agreement Holders) must submit a report to the applicable EPA regional office within 30 days after the ocean disposal of the marine mammal carcass authorized under Section A of the MPRSA general permit. Government entities and Stranding Agreement Holders may use this reporting form to submit reports to the appropriate EPA regional contact.
