PURPOSE: The purpose of this notice is to state the EPA's intention to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit under the authority of Section 402 of the Clean Water Act.

ACTIVITY: Discharge of treated water from the City of Wagner wastewater treatment facility. The facility is located in the northeast ¼ of Section 34, Township 96 north, Range 63 west, approximately ¼ mile northeast of the city in Charles Mix County, South Dakota. The facility discharge point is located at latitude 43.091111° N, longitude 98.273889° W. The facility is located within the exterior boundaries of the Yankton Sioux Tribe Reservation.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Comment period ends 30 calendar days after the date of publication of this notice. Comments must be directed to: VelRey Lozano (8WP-CWW), U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8, 1595 Wynkoop Street, Denver, CO 80202-1129. All comments received prior to the end of the comment period will be considered in the formulation of any final permit determination, and will be part of the administrative record. Any commenter may request a public hearing and the EPA will hold a hearing if the response to this notice indicates significant public interest. The EPA is also requesting comments on the possible adverse effects of reissuing the permit on historic properties and/or cultural resources in the area.
