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- 4. This facility is subject to the record keeping requirements of 25 PA Code §129.95.
- 5 NOx emissions from the main stack shall not be in excess of .7 lb/MMBtu based on a 30 day rolling average.
- 6 A yearly NOx emission limit for this facility is established as 5933 tpy.
- Compliance with the NOx emission limit in Special Condition #5 and #6 shall be established based on emission data obtained from a certified CEM installed, maintained, and operated in accordance with 25 Pa. Code Chapters 123 and 139.
